Reopening Health & Safety Plan



GREEN PHASE

GREEN PHASE encourages social distancing and limits large social gatherings to allow for the prioritization of student and staff health and safety. While this phase will provide a **full time on-campus learning environment**, it will be equally important to continue to monitor public health indicators and adjust strategies to mitigate the community spread.



Capacity

- All K-12 students able to return to school buildings
- Classroom arrangements to maximize distance and assigned seating for all areas
- Clearly marked traffic patterns in hallways and designated UP & DOWN stairwells
- Limited visitors permitted inside the building
- Parents and children complete home health assessment
- Learning options available



Food Service

- K-12 will eat in cafeteria or alternate locations to provide better physical distancing
- Pre-packaged food items will be served by food service staff



Schedule

- Students will attend Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, Friday
- Staff will report on Wednesday for weekly online class prep and staff development



Masks

- Each student/staff member will receive a face covering for:
 - Class
 - Transitions (halls, common areas)
- When not able to physically distance
- Entering and exiting buildings



Transportation

- Face coverings will be required while on the bus
- Students will sit 2 per seat
- Buses will load as normal with students wearing masks
- Parents encouraged to provide transportation



Disinfecting

- All high touch surfaces & restrooms will be cleaned with disinfectant
- Building and buses disinfected nightly
- Sanitizer and wipes in all classrooms and lobby for ongoing/daily use
- Deep cleaning of buildings



YELLOW PHASE

During the **YELLOW PHASE**, social distancing and other safety measures will be implemented to further prioritize student and staff health and safety. While this phase will still provide a **full time on-campus learning environment**, some protocols will be adjusted as we monitor public health indicators and adjust strategies to mitigate the community spread.



Capacity

- All K-12 students able to return to school buildings
- Hallways and stairways designed for one-way traffic as feasible
- Classroom arrangements to maximize distance and assigned seating for all areas
- No visitors permitted inside the buildings
- Temperatures taken before entering the building
- Parents and children complete home health assessment
- Learning options available



Food Service

- K-12 will eat in cafeteria or alternate locations to provide better physical distancing to the fullest extent possible
- Pre-packaged food items will be served by food service staff



Schedule

- K-12 will attend Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, Friday
- Staff will report on Wednesday for weekly online class prep and staff development



Masks

- Each student/staff member will receive a face covering for:
- Class Transition (halls, common areas)
- When not able to physically distance
- Entering and Exiting buildings



Transportation

- Face coverings will be required while on the bus
- Students will sit 2 per seat
- Buses will load and dismiss 1 by 1 when feasible
- Parents encouraged to provide transportation



Disinfecting

- All high touch surfaces & restrooms will be cleaned with greater frequency with disinfectant
- Buildings and buses disinfected nightly with greater frequency
- Sanitizer & wipes in all classrooms and lobby for ongoing/daily use
- Deep cleaning of buildings



RED PHASE

The **RED PHASE** schools remain **closed for in-person instruction** with student services such as school meal programs continued.

K-12 will follow a Full Time Virtual Learning environment.



Capacity

- All school buildings will be closed
- Only essential workers will be allowed into the buildings on a limited basis



Food Service

- Schools will continue to provide meal programs



Schedule

- K-12 will be attending full-time Virtual Learning with Google Classroom
